Hoover City Schools reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, or any part of any bid, and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bid. All information asked for in this Invitation for Bid, including all documents, procedures, insurance certificates, and any other information asked for must accompany the bid. Failure to include any asked for information may result in the bid being declared non-responsive.

General Contractors will be required to make a good faith effort to include MBE and DBE Companies in the execution of this project.

Construction contracts shall be awarded only to qualified Contractors, licensed by the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, as required by Title 34, Chapter 8, and Code of Alabama. Contracts in excess of \$50,000 shall be awarded only to Contractors licensed as required by the 1978 Code of Alabama, Title 34, and Chapter 8 as amended. Bidders must be "responsible" in accordance with criteria in the bid and as stipulated by Title 30-2-3-(e) of the Code of Alabama.

In Accordance with Act 2013-205 – Certificate of Exception from Sales and Use Tax for Governmental Entities, contractors are to exclude sales tax from their base bid, but must account for tax savings on the attached ABC Form C-3.

A Cashier's Check drawn on an Alabama Bank, or a bid bond executed by a Surety company duly authorized and qualified to make such bonds in Alabama, payable to the Hoover City Schools in the amount of 5% of the amount of bids, but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the Bidder's bid. Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price will be required when the Contract is presented by the Contractor to the Authority.

IMMIGRATION LAW COMPLIANCE - Bidders must provide proof of enrollment in E-Verify as a condition for the award of the contract.

All non-United States citizens who perform any work pursuant to this agreement shall have all necessary papers to verify their right to legally work in the United States, and such paperwork shall be available for inspection during normal business hours by Hoover City Schools.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1 GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.1 This will be for the use of Hoover City Schools, Hoover, Alabama (hereinafter called "HCS").
- 1.2 **HCS is Tax Exempt.**
- 1.3 Payment terms are net 30. Other payment terms can be negotiated.
- 1.4 No interpretation or modification made to any respondent as to the meaning of the Invitation for Bid shall be binding on HCS unless submitted in writing and distributed as an addendum by HCS Operations Department. Verbal information obtained otherwise will not be considered in awarding of contract. All addenda shall become part of the Invitation for Bid.
- 1.5 **IMPORTANT: It is required that the Bidder Information Form, Exhibit #1, furnished with this Invitation for Bid, be completed and submitted with your bid. Failure to comply with this request may eliminate your bid from consideration.**
- 1.6 **All bid responses, technical information and any other attachments in response to this Invitation for Bid must be submitted in triplicate on the form provided (THE ORIGINAL BID AND ATTACHMENTS WITH ORIGINAL SIGNATURE AND TWO EXACT COPIES OF THE ENTIRE BID RESPONSE). Bidders who fail to follow this format may be disqualified from the evaluation and award phase of the bid.**
- 1.7 Bids having any erasures or corrections must be initialed in ink. Bids must be signed in ink by an official authorized representative.
- 1.8 **All information asked for in this Invitation for Bid, including all documents, procedures, insurance certificates, and any other information asked for, must accompany the bid. Failure to include any asked for information may result in the bid being declared non-responsive.**
- 1.9 HCS reserves the right to waive any informality in any offer; to reject any or all offers, in whole or in part; and to accept the offer most advantageous to HCS should it be deemed in its best interest to do so.
- 1.10 The attached specifications cover minimum standards; any alternate services or equipment bid offered should meet or exceed HCS's needs. HCS, acting in its best interest, will award this contract to one or multiple vendors. HCS shall be the sole judge of the quality or inequality of the items proposed in this bid. HCS's decision shall be final.
- 1.11 The use of specific names and numbers are not intended to restrict the bidding of any seller and/or manufacturer, but is solely for the purpose of indicating the type, size and quality of materials, products, service, or equipment considered best adapted to HCS's intended use.
- 1.12 Products submitted on this bid should meet or exceed the stated specifications, which are intended to set a standard of quality and are not intended to limit competition.
- 1.13 Proprietary specifications may be waived for functional equivalents offered, if authorized by requesting department.

- 1.14 Bidder further agrees to demonstrate, in Jefferson County, Alabama, the materials and/or equipment within five (5) days of request from HCS and at Bidder's expense that is offered as equivalent to but not matching HCS's specifications.
- 1.15 All costs incurred by the company to respond to this solicitation will be wholly the responsibility of the Bidder. All copies and contents of the bid, attachments, and explanations thereto submitted in response to this Invitation for Bid, except copyrighted material, shall become the property of HCS, regardless if a Consultant is selected.
- 1.16 Bidder agrees to furnish all equipment, accessories, material, services and/or delivery, as specified per Bid Documents and Technical Specifications. It is the responsibility of the Bidder under the terms of this contract to comply with all applicable codes of HCS such as safety, licensing, EPA Regulations, etc.
- 1.17 Submissions may be withdrawn, modified, and resubmitted prior to the formal bid opening due date. Any submission modification(s) submitted after the bid opening due date will not be considered.
- 1.18 HCS is not responsible for delays by the Air Courier, Delivery or Messenger Service, US Postal Service, the internal mail delivery system of HCS, or any other means of delivery employed by the Bidder. **Bidders are encouraged to call the Coordinator of Operations at (205) 439-1134 to ensure mailed bids have been received.** Similarly, HCS is not responsible for, and will not open, any bid responses which are received later than the date and time indicated above. **Late bids will be retained in the file, unopened.**
- 1.19 Shipping will be F.O.B. Destination, Hoover City Schools, Hoover, Alabama. Unit prices quoted must include any and all shipping and handling charges. Any freight claims will be the responsibility of the Bidder.
- 1.20 HCS is strongly committed to equal opportunity in solicitation of Invitation for Bids. HCS encourages Bidders to share this commitment. Each Bidder submitting a bid agrees not to refuse to hire, discharge, promote, demote, or to otherwise discriminate against any person otherwise qualified solely because of race, creed, sex, national origin or disability.
- 1.21 The Bidder must have necessary business licenses as required by the State, County, and City.
- 1.22 The undersigned certifies that this bid is genuine and not collusive.
- 1.23 Subject to applicable law or regulations, the content of each Bidder's Proposal shall become public information upon the effective date of any resulting contract.
- 1.24 If a single bid response is received for this Invitation for Bid, the bid will be rejected in accordance with Title 41-16-50-a-1 of the Alabama Code. This bid will be opened, but will not be read publicly. We will proceed with negotiations for a lower price with the rejected Bidder and other Bidders by means of sealed quotes. The rejected Bidders initial offer will not be disclosed to other bidders prior to the awarding of a contract. The award will be made to the company offering the lowest negotiated quotation, provided that all conditions and specifications of HCS are met.

2 TAX EXEMPTION

- 2.1 HCS is tax exempt.
- 2.2 **In accordance with Legislative Act 2013-205, Code of Alabama (1975) Section 40-9-14.1, at the time of Bid, provide an accounting of sales tax on the Accounting of Sales Tax form, Exhibit 4. Failure to provide an accounting of sales tax shall render the bid non-responsive. Other than determining responsiveness, sales tax accounting shall not affect the bid pricing nor be considered in the determination of the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.**
- 2.3 **Each contractor and subcontractor must make application for qualification of the Sales and Use Tax exemption using Alabama Department of Revenue Form ST: EXC-01 for each tax exempt project. The application is available on the Alabama Department of Revenue's website at: <https://revenue.alabama.gov/salestax/ST-EXC-01.pdf>.**

- 2.4 **Contractors and subcontractors for qualifying projects will be required to file monthly consumers use tax returns and report all exempt purchases for ongoing projects, as well as all taxable purchases on one return. These returns are required to be filed through the Alabama Department of Revenue's online tax return filing and payment portal, My Alabama Taxes (<https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>).**

3 DISPUTES

- 3.1 Any contract agreement that is issued based on this Invitation for Bid, the parties shall agree that the contract agreement is made and entered into in Jefferson County, Alabama, and that all services, materials, and equipment to be rendered pursuant to said contract agreement are to be delivered in Jefferson County, Alabama. The interpretation and enforcement of this contract agreement will be governed by laws of the State of Alabama. The parties agree that jurisdiction and venue over all disputes arising under this contract agreement shall be the Circuit Court of Jefferson County Alabama, Birmingham Division.

4 PERFORMANCE

- 4.1 In the event the Bidder defaults in performing this contract, it agrees to pay HCS its reasonable costs incurred in remedying such default, including reasonable attorney's fees.
- 4.2 The Bidder will be held responsible for any damage to HCS's property caused by his work or workmen and for any project delays due to lack of response to HCS's needs. The property shall be restored to its original condition as required by HCS.

5 PRICE QUOTATION

- 5.1 **IMPORTANT: It is required that the BID FORM, Exhibit #2, furnished with this Invitation for Bid be completed and submitted with your bid. DO NOT send generated price lists as your bid. Failure to comply with this request may eliminate your bid from consideration.**
- 5.2 HCS's payment terms are net 30. Other payment terms can be negotiated.
- 5.3 It is the Bidder's responsibility to verify all information and measurements, and to obtain any clarification necessary prior to submitting the bid response. HCS is not liable for any errors or misinterpretations made by the Bidder in response to this Invitation for Bid.
- 5.4 **The successful Bidder under the specifications required in this Invitation for Bid shall furnish at its expense, all equipment, labor, tools, supplies, transportation (including fuel surcharge, if applicable), insurance, and other expenses necessary to fully perform any phase of the requirements of this Invitation for Bid. Prices shall remain firm for the term of the contract.**
- 5.5 HCS reserves the right to enter into contract negotiations with the selected bidder. If HCS and the selected Bidder cannot negotiate a successful contract, HCS may terminate negotiations and begin negotiations with the next selected Bidder. This process will continue until a contract has been executed or all proposals have been rejected. No Bidder shall have any rights against the county arising from such negotiations.
- 5.6 In accordance with the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 41-16-50 (a), in the event a bid is received for an item of personal property or services to be purchased or contracted for from a person, firm, or corporation deemed to be a responsible bidder, having a place of business within the local preference zone of Jefferson County, Alabama, and the bid is no more than five percent greater than the bid of the lowest responsible bidder, HCS may award the contract to the resident responsible bidder.
- 5.7 In the event that, during the term of the agreement, the Successful Bidder is required to increase wages and/or payroll burden costs as a direct result of any determination or action by any Federal, State, or Local Government, HCS agrees to permit the Successful Bidder to increase its rates proportionally from the date the increase becomes law. The increase(s) cannot be implemented until HCS's Purchasing Department receives a new rate schedule and a letter explaining in detail the circumstances necessitating the increase. Bidders should be aware of any and all possible increases in wages, Social Security, Federal, State, and Local taxes which may apply during contract term and make HCS aware of same.

6 QUANTITIES

- 6.1 Quantities shown are estimates, and are not a guarantee to buy in the amount shown.
- 6.2 Bidder agrees that HCS will be charged no more for item(s) bid than the State of Alabama, and that in the event of a price reduction; HCS will receive the benefit of such reduction on any undelivered portion of the contract.

7 IMMIGRATION LAW COMPLIANCE

- 7.1 Bidders must provide proof of enrollment in E-Verify as a condition for the award of the contract. Failure to submit a Memorandum of Understanding with the bid may eliminate your bid from consideration.**
- 7.2 By signing this contract, the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

- 8.1 If any owner, officer, partner, board or director member, employee, or holder of more than 5% of the fair market value of the Bidder's firm or any member of their households is an employee of HCS, this information must be included in the solicitation response. Failure to disclose this information in the response may result in the elimination of your bid from consideration.
- 8.2 IMPORTANT: It is required that the Disclosure Statement of relationship between bidder and employees/officials of HCS, Exhibit #3, furnished with this Invitation for Bid, be completed and submitted with your bid. Failure to comply with this request may eliminate your bid from consideration.**
- 8.3 If any owner, officer, partner, board, director member, employee, or holder of more than 5% of the fair market value of the Bidder's firm or any member of their households is an employee of HCS; and the Bidder's firm is awarded a contract as a result of this Invitation for Bid, then within ten (10) days after the contract is entered into, the Bidder agrees to file a copy of that contract with the State of Alabama Ethics Commission in accordance with Code of Alabama, Section 36-25-11 and upon request by HCS furnish evidence of such filing.
- 8.4 By accepting payments resulting from this bid, Bidder certifies that to its knowledge no HCS employee or official, and no family members of a HCS employee or official, will receive a benefit from these payments, except as has been previously disclosed, in writing, to HCS on the Disclosure Statement of relationship between bidder and employees/officials of HCS, which is part of this Invitation for Bid.

9 REFERENCES

- 10.1 Bidder must submit with the bid, three (3) current business references for contact which the Bidder has successfully provided services similar to those required in this Invitation for Bid. The references must include company name, address, contact name, phone number, and email address. Failure to comply with this request may eliminate your bid from consideration.**

10 GENERAL LITIGATION DISCLOSURE

- 11.1 Bidder must describe any pending, contemplated or ongoing administrative or judicial proceedings material to Bidder's business, finances or products including, but not limited to, any litigation, consent orders, debarment or contracts with any local, state or federal regulatory agency issued to Bidder or to any parent or subsidiary to Bidder.

11 DETAILED CONDITIONS

11.1 Successful Bidder hereby agrees to begin this project as specified in the contract documents on or before a date to be specified in the "Notice to Proceed" by HCS and to provide this service at the specified price for a period of one year beginning May 23, 2020, HCS intends to renew this contract annually, at its option based on service and pricing, for two (2) additional service periods of one (1) year each.

11.2 **A PRE-BID MEETING is scheduled for January 26th, 2021 @ 1:00 pm in the Conference Room at Hoover City Schools Operations Center located at 1070 Buccaneer Drive, Hoover, AL 35244. The bid will be discussed, followed by a question/answer period. Each prospective bidder will be able schedule with the Coordinator of Operations to visit each school for a walk through if needed at the Pre-Bid Meeting.**

11.3 **The bids will be submitted to the HCS Board at the February 2021 Board Meeting. Following Board approval, the Successful Bidder (s) will be notified immediately in order to facilitate moving forward with the contract.**

11.4 INSURANCE

12.4.1 Hold Harmless and Indemnification: Contracting party agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend HCS, its elected officers, employees, past and present, its employees, and its agents, past and present, (hereinafter referred to in this paragraph collectively as "HCS"), from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, judgments, liens, penalties, interest, and expenses, including but not limited to court costs and attorneys' fees, for liability claimed against or imposed upon HCS because of bodily injury, death or property damages, real or personal, including loss of use thereof arising out of or as a consequence of the breach of any duty or obligations of the contracting party included in this agreement, Bidder's performance or failure to perform any obligations contained in this document, the inaccuracy of any representations or warranties of the Bidder contained herein; negligent acts, errors or omissions, including engineering and/or professional error, fault, mistake or negligence of Integrator, its employees, agents, representatives, or subcontractors, their employees, agents or representatives in connections with or incident to the performance of this agreement, or arising out of Worker's Compensation claims, Unemployment Compensation claims, or Unemployment Disability claims of employees of company and/or its subcontractors or claims under similar such law or obligations, the payment or non-payment of any taxes relating to any monies paid to the Bidder pursuant to this Agreement, the foregoing provisions, and all liabilities of the Bidder hereunder, shall survive the termination of this Agreement. Company obligation under this Section shall not extend to any liability caused by the sole negligence of HCS, or its employees. **The certificate must include the added additional Insured by Endorsement:**

11.4.1.1 **Hoover City Schools and employees must be listed as additional insured.**

11.4.1.2 **30 day(s) written cancellation notice.**

11.4.2 The certificate must be received by HCS Operations Department within fifteen (15) days of request. Failure to comply with this request may eliminate the bid from consideration.

11.4.3 HCS reserves the right to terminate any resulting contract, if the Bidder fails to keep the insurance policies in force for the below amounts or for the duration of the contract period.

11.4.4 Before beginning work, Bidder shall provide a current certificate of insurance with the following coverage:

11.4.4.1 Worker's Compensation Insurance per Alabama State Law.

11.4.4.1.1 Worker's Compensation Coverage shall be provided in accordance with the statutory coverage required in Alabama. A group insurer must submit a certificate of HCS from the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations approving the group insurance plan. A self-insurer must submit a certificate from the Alabama Department of Industrial Relations stating the Contractor qualifies to pay its own worker's compensation claims.

11.4.4.1.2 Employer's Liability Insurance limits shall be at least:

11.4.4.1.3 Bodily Injury by Accident - \$1,000,000 per accident.

11.4.4.1.4 Bodily Injury by Disease - \$1,000,000 per employee.

11.4.4.2 Commercial Business Automobile Liability Insurance

11.4.4.2.1 Commercial Business Automobile Liability Insurance which shall include coverage for bodily injury and property damage arising from the operation of any owned, non-owned or hired automobile. The Commercial Business Automobile Liability Insurance Policy shall provide not less than \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limits for each occurrence.

11.4.4.3 Commercial General Liability Insurance

11.4.4.3.1 Commercial General Liability Insurance written on an ISO Occurrence Form (current edition) or equivalent, shall include, but need not be limited to, coverage for bodily injury and property damage arising from premises and operations liability, products and completed operations liability, blasting and explosion, collapse of structures, and underground damage, personal injury liability and contractual liability. The Commercial General Liability Insurance shall provide at minimum the following limits:

12. BONDS

12.1 A Cashier's Check drawn on an Alabama Bank, or a bid bond executed by a Surety company duly authorized and qualified to make such bonds in Alabama, payable to Hoover City Schools in the amount of \$1000, must accompany the Bidder's bid.

13 TERMINATION

13.1 This contract may be terminated by HCS with a thirty (30) day written notice to the Bidder regardless of reason. Any violation of this agreement shall constitute a breach and default of this agreement. Upon such breach, HCS shall have the right to immediately terminate the contract; Bidder shall be paid for services rendered to the date of termination; and HCS shall have no further financial obligation to the Bidder. Such termination shall not relieve the Bidder of any liability to HCS for damages sustained by virtue of a breach by the Bidder.

14 DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS –

- 14.1 Bidder shall be responsible for all permits, labor, materials, and equipment.
- 14.2 Bidder shall be responsible for adequately barricading work area, prohibiting general access from entering the work locations as appropriate during the course of the contract.
- 14.3 Bidder shall provide to the HCS, emergency contact numbers for members of management in order to facilitate problem solving which may arise during business hours, as well as non-business hours.
- 14.4 Bidder shall be available to commence work following final issuance of contract and after the last day of school for students that is currently scheduled for May 27th, 2021 and all work that is committed to be completed prior to first day of students that is scheduled for 8/05/2021 as well as on the last date for students through the first day for Teachers to return on the preceding years of this bid for the specifically identified Items by Principals or designee once contract (s) are awarded . All other work being done based on same per sqft or Lft basis must be done at periods of time where students are not in school such as nights, weekends, holiday and spring breaks, summer breaks etc.
- 14.5 Bidder shall clean the surroundings area and remove all debris from the work area each day before leaving the site.
- 14.6 Bidder shall properly store equipment in rooms or locations that have been approved by HCS representatives in advance only.
- 14.7 All Bidder employees working at the HCS are required to wear either a uniform or company ID properly identifying them as a bidder employee. The uniform should be clean and include the company logo and the employee's name. Clothing other than uniform should be appropriate for the professional work place. T-shirts without sleeves and with inappropriate language, flip-flops, and caps with inappropriate messages are prohibited. The decision of whether a garment is appropriate belongs to the HCS and is final. All Bidder employees must follow OSHA standards.
- 14.8 All Bidder employees that will be performing work at any of HCS buildings must comply with HCS Background visitor management system (RAPTOR) for sex offender registry background checks in order to preform work identified herein. Anyone that is Identified as a registered sex offender by the RAPTOR Visitor System will be denied access to HCS buildings.
- 14.9 All Bidder employees are always expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner .
